2021-2022 GRANT WINNER

NSEF is excited to announce our 2021 Education Grant Winner, Ms. Kerry Delduchetto, from Roxboro Rd. Elementary.

Kerry's grant entitled, " Social Emotional Book Library, Part 2" is an extension of a grant she applied for and won last year. This new grant will provide an additional 20 books for students in K-4th grades at RRE.

By implementing Bibliotherapy, or using books as pathway to discussion, counselors will hold sessions with students, either individually or in groups, once a week for 20-30 minutes. The books will also be used in conjunction to traditional "talk" counseling or used as a springboard for discussion or creative activity. The books will be used as a supplement to virtual learning as well.

Some signs that a counselor looks for to determine counseling has been successful are:

- The child expresses needs openly
- The child is able to accept responsibility for behavior
- The child has less disciplinary referrals

NSEF is glad to help Kerry promote one the district's top goals - enhancing Social Emotional learning with our students.

Kerry's grant was presented to the NSCSD Board of Education on May 3rd where she received a certificate of congratulations. It should also be noted that Kerry was also one of the key participants in helping the NSEF identify students in need of desks at home for our project with Operation Northern Comfort. With all that staff has dealt with this year of COVID-19, we want to thank Kerry for going above and beyond!

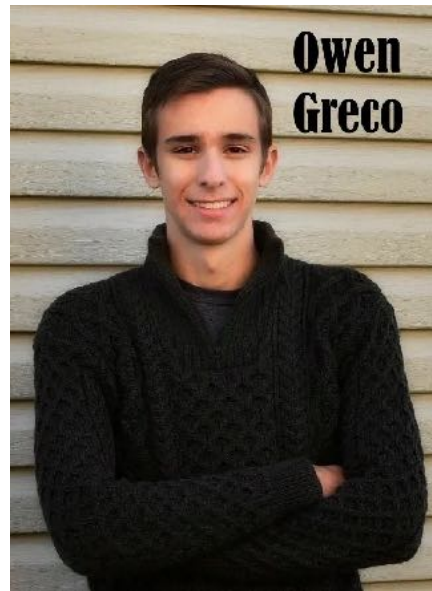

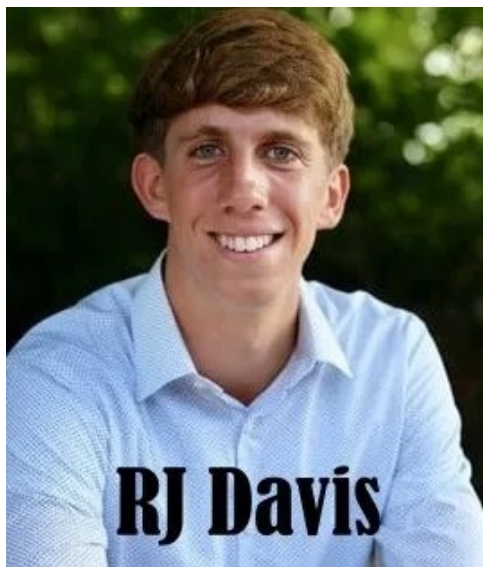
2021 SCHOLARSHIP WINNERS
